2. Pick styles and fabrics based on job roles and functions



TRADESPEOPLE

Similar to safety sensitive roles, tradespeople will generally need hi-vis, durable and comfortable workwear.

Tradespeople often rely on word of mouth and local networking for new business. Your uniform is a versatile marketing and branding tool that can help you connect with more clients. If your company has a specific theme or mascot, try incorporating elements of that theme into your attire to really make your brand stand out.





SAFETY SENSITIVE ROLES – LABOURERS & OPERATORS

These roles involve physically demanding and often dangerous tasks. Typically, uniforms will have high-visibility and reflective elements, and will adhere to Australian Standards. Certain jobs like working with high voltage electricity, food and freezers, chemicals, or heavy machinery will require hi-vis, flameresistant, weatherproof clothing, plus additional PPE and steel capped footwear to protect them from hazards. Check the security protocols at your workplace first, and ensure your uniforms meet regulatory requirements.



SITE MANAGERS, INSPECTORS & ENGINEERS

These roles oversee workers on-site and will need uniforms that convey their authority and administrative role, like a collared shirt or jacket. They will also need to wear hi-vis and safety wear appropriate for the job site.

MANAGEMENT & EXECUTIVES

Leadership roles should project professionalism and authority, and contribute to a positive and organised environment. Think suits, dress shirts, ties, or blazers. Hi-vis workwear may also be needed if they are in factories or at job sites.



SALES & MARKETING

Client-facing roles should project professionalism and credibility to build trust and ease in clients. Consider classic, well-fitted attire like suits, dress shirts and vests for men, and suits, business dresses or blouses for women. This may vary depending on the dress code and culture of your workplace.



ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF & EXECUTIVE ASSISTANTS

These roles require a polished and professional appearance. Opt for high-quality fabrics like wool, cotton or blends that convey professionalism and comfort. Depending on your industry, staff may still require hi-vis workwear.





LOGISTICS AND DELIVERY

These roles require uniforms that are easily identifiable to ensure the safety of all visitors and staff, on and offsite. For a cohesive and professional image, these uniforms should be branded.

OPERATIONAL OFFICE ROLES

Positions like estimators, engineers, designers, technicians, accountants, IT, human resources and more may not have a specific 'uniform', but presenting a polished and professional image is key. Consider a smart polo shirt or dress shirt for all staff for a cohesive look. Hi-vis workwear may also be necessary.



THINGS TO CONSIDER

- Check that the garments you pick meet the Australian Standards for safety and hi-vs workwear.
 Depending on your job, the requirements may include highvisibility, sun protection, reflective taping for night time, and more.
 These standards are periodically reviewed and amended.
- Inspect your garments for signs of wear and tear every two weeks or monthly. Early detection prevents issues that could compromise your safety and performance.
- The size of your logo decoration can affect compliance. Generally, a logo smaller than 10cm x 10cm is acceptable. Methods like embroidery or heat transfer that don't compromise the reflective properties of the fabric are preferred. Printing directly on the fabric might reduce reflectivity and affect compliance.

DIRECT TO FILM HEAT TRANSFER

DTF is a revolutionary heat transfer printing method that offers a vibrant and super high-definition solution for branding t-shirts. It blends the best of vinyl heat transfer with screen printing.

DYE SUBLIMATION

Dye sublimation uses heat to transfer dyes onto polyester fabric. The dyes turn into a gas, permeate the fabric, and solidify, creating vibrant, long-lasting prints with excellent colour accuracy and a smooth finish.



SCREEN PRINTING

Screen printing has long been a reliable and versatile branding method, despite newer and faster technologies now available. The process involves using stencils and multiple layers of ink to create detailed and long-lasting designs.

VINYL HEAT TRANSFER

Vinyl heat transfer printing involves cutting a design from coloured vinyl and using a heat press to transfer it onto fabric. This process delivers a clean and lasting look with vibrant colours, making it ideal for smaller quantities and designs that require sharp details.

We used the steel grey/ black/white Cambridge polo as the base shirt for its subtle striped collar and cuffs, and easy-care, breathable cotton-backed fabric that suits staff across all departments.

We love the Streetworx Comfort Pant's stretchy fabric for comfort and mobility, with plenty of pockets. Also paired with the Comfort Short.

The Hi Vis Short Sleeve Shirt is perfect for its 100% lightweight cotton fabric that keeps workers cool and safe while out in the elements. We also added a long sleeve version for cooler days and a vest for onsite visitors.







For the sales reps and managers who need a flexible uniform suited for office meetings and site visits, we added tailored shirts.




